Emergency Bunker Surcharge (EBS) – USD75/Teu. Siam Singapore Service (SSS):

Implemented 01 April 2011. Ports affected:

Bangkok (both PAT and Bangkok Modern Terminals), Laem Chabang, Lat Krabang.

Emergency Bunker Surcharge (EBS) – USD150/Teu. E/Indies Straits Service (EIS):

Implemented 01 April 2011. Ports affected:

Yangon & Penang.

Ramadhan Season Surcharge (RSS) – USD200/Teu. All shipments to M/East & Gulf.

Implemented 15 July 2011. Ports affected:

Colombo, Karachi, Jebel Ali Dammam, Mundra, Tuticorin, Cochin, Bahrain, Muscat, Bandar Abbas, Shuwaikh, Doha, Sharjah, Abu Dhabi and Riyadh.
